COMMITTEES OF THE NATIONAL INDUSTRIAL TRANSPORTATION LEAGUE

The following is a summary of the specific duties and responsibilities of each of The National Industrial Transportation League's committees. Committee participation in open to League members only.

Committees

<u>Air Transportation Committee</u> - The Air Transportation Committee monitors and makes recommendations on all issues pertaining to air transportation of both cargo and passengers which are of interest to the League.

<u>Audit Committee</u> - The Audit Committee oversees the League's yearly audits as well as the accuracy of its general accounting records. It also monitors the League's general financial needs.

<u>Education Committee</u> - The Education Committee is responsible for developing seminars, conferences, and other education and training opportunities.

<u>Highway Transportation Committee</u> - The Highway Transportation Committee monitors and makes recommendations on all issues pertaining to highway transportation including small shipments and postal issues.

<u>Information Technology Advancement Committee</u> - The ITA Committee monitors and makes recommendations on all issues pertaining to computers and computer applications for transportation and distribution. Its responsibilities include interacting with the private and public sector on standards for data communication and information exchange as well as providing assistance to the membership on these matters.

<u>Ocean Transportation Committee</u> -The Ocean Transportation Committee monitors and makes recommendations on all matters pertaining to import and export transportation by water. Its responsibilities include rates, agreements, equipment, facilities, and port terminal fees, as well as the inland portion of any international shipments moving under a single factor rate, service, or agreement.

<u>Railroad Transportation Committee</u> - The Railroad Transportation Committee monitors and makes recommendations on all issues pertaining to cargo moved by rail. Its responsibilities include rates and related matters, classification, facilities, mergers and consolidations, equipment supply, demurrage and storage, accessorial services, and safety.
